SCHOOL DAY CHANGES IN JANUARY

Dear parents,

We believe that the more time students spend engaged in their studies with excellent teachers, the greater their opportunities for academic and future success. That is why, in our continuing efforts to improve student learning, we will be expanding the school day by twenty (20) minutes. Beginning on January 5, 2009 students attending both Burr Ridge CCSD 180 schools will be receiving (20) minutes more of instruction.

In order to make sure we have busses to get students to and from school, we have arranged the extra twenty (20) minutes as follows. We will be adding twenty minutes to the beginning of the Anne M. Jeans Elementary School day (8:15-3:20) and splitting the ten minutes at the beginning of the BRMS day and at the end of the Burr Ridge Middle School day (7:45-3:00).

Beginning January 5th, Anne M. Jeans Elementary students will begin school twenty minutes earlier at 8:15AM and end at the regular time 3:20PM .

Students at Burr Ridge Middle School will begin school ten minutes earlier at 7:45AM and end ten minutes later at 3:00PM.

New bus route times will be distributed in December.

We believe that the additional minutes in the school day will have a positive impact on our students and we are happy to be able to provide this additional time for engagement with our students. We firmly believe that we have the most outstanding teaching staff in all of DuPage County and we are fortunate that our students have this additional time to benefit from that expertise.
