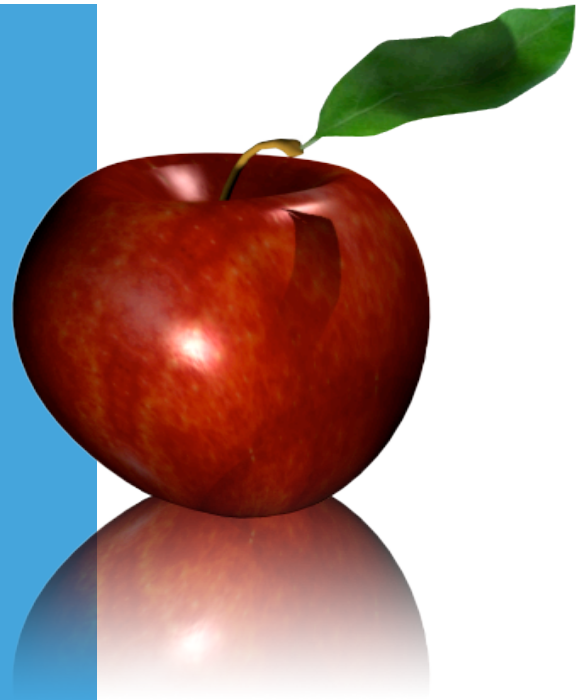

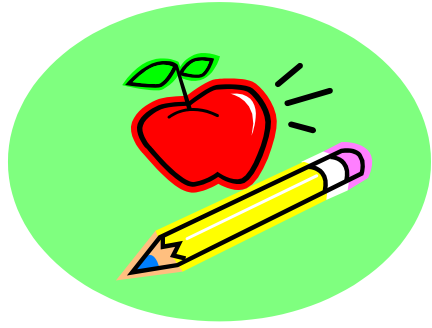

Burr Ridge Schools Make Illinois Honor Roll for Second Year!

For the second year in a row, both BRMS and AMJES have been named to the State of Illinois Honor Roll for Excellence. The District schools were among 425 schools in Illinois honored as Spotlight Schools. The criteria for selecting Spotlight Schools are rigorous. In addition to making Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP), the schools must demonstrate that students are successful across all demographic groups. The Illinois State Board commented that Spotlight Schools like BRMS and AMJES, “know how to help all students succeed.”
