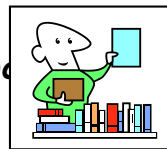

Math Matters

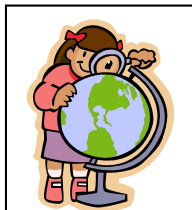
All of our students are continuing to work diligently reviewing division facts and learning the process of division.
