Policy 6:190

Instruction

Extracurricular and Co-Curricular Activities

The Superintendent shall approve all District-sponsored extracurricular and co-curricular activities, using the following criteria:

1. The activity will contribute to the leadership abilities, social well-being, self-realization, good citizenship, or general growth of participants.
2. Fees are reasonable and do not exceed the actual cost of operation.
3. Students' interests are considered.
4. The activity will be supervised by a school-approved sponsor.

Building Principals are responsible for the scheduling and announcing of student extracurricular and co-curricular activities.

Non-school sponsored student groups are governed by the District's policy on use of school buildings.

Academic Criteria for Participation

Selection of participants is at the discretion of the teachers, sponsors, or coaches, provided that the selection criteria conform to the District's policies. Students must satisfy all academic standards and must comply with the activity's rules and the student conduct code. Eligibility requirements for IESA sponsored activities will follow IESA guidelines. Eligibility requirements for Southeast DuPage Conference sponsored activities will follow SDEAA guidelines.
