Policy 6:290

Instruction

Homework

Teachers may give homework to students to aid in the student's educational development. Homework should be an application or adaptation of a classroom experience and should not be assigned for disciplinary purposes.

The Board recognizes that a reasonable amount of study and preparation is necessary for the scholastic growth of pupils. It is also aware that the amount of preparation should increase as the child progresses through the grades.

However, the Board will not look with favor upon an inordinate amount of homework assignments. It is the Board's consensus that students can develop better study habits and attain a higher level of achievement if they are permitted to study during class time and under the supervision of the regular teacher.
