Fund Raising

SOLICITING FUNDS FROM STUDENTS

The school shall earnestly seek to educate pupils in the services performed by humanitarian agencies. When any such humanitarian agency seeks the District's support in a fund-raising activity, District students may be permitted to engage in the agency's solicitation of funds if the fund-raising activity:

1. Has been approved by the Superintendent;
2. Is conducted under the District's administrative guidelines and rules;
3. Has been selected by staff, a student organization or a representative group of the student body; and
4. Has been presented by the sponsors as a voluntary project.

STUDENT PRODUCTION OF GOODS AND SERVICES

Students may produce services and materials for community organizations or groups only to the extent that such production furthers student educational development. Care must be exercised by the administration in interpreting this policy to avoid pupil exploitation.

FUND RAISING BY STUDENTS

The Board of Education recognizes the appropriate educational values, need for additional revenue for student activities, and parent involvement that fund raising provides. The Board of Education will approve student organizations and parent organizations which sponsor fund raising activities. Student organization sponsored activities will have schedule preference over other organizations.

The Board of Education will permit student council fund raising which benefits the activities and programs for the students attending our schools.

Any child's participation in fund raising activities is voluntary.

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
