The salute to the flag is to be part of each day's opening class exercise.

The Flag of the United States of America shall be raised above each school house and at other appropriate places during all school sessions, weather permitting. The flag shall be raised before the opening of school and taken down at its close each day.

Commemoration of special days and events as defined by the School Code of Illinois shall be a definite and valuable part of the school program.
