Avoid the Lines by Pre-Registering: Starting August 1st Parents New to the District Can Register Starting July 1st

Do you want to beat the Registration Day rush so that you can spend your first moments at school getting off to a great start by **meeting your child's teacher?**

Avoid the lines by participating in our **Pre-Registration Days August 1st-August 11th**.

Stop by the school office at Burr Ridge Middle School from 9AM-4:30PM to Pre-Register for school.

Just be sure to bring:

1. Proof of Residency,
2. Prepare for fees,
3. Sign off on district parent information.

Students **new to the district can start to Pre-Register early beginning July 1st** (call 630-734-6670 for an appointment) must bring these additional items to complete the pre-registration process:

1. Birth Certificate,
2. IEP (If applicable),
3. Transfer Paperwork.

After Pre-Registering skip to the front of the line and meet your teachers during our **mandatory Registration Day**.

Students are **not officially enrolled until they attend the Registration Day on August 15th**.

How to Prove Residency

Here's a list of the information you need to come prepared with:

Two (2) Current proofs of residency:

One Document from Category I:

Current Signed Lease (**with student(s) name(s) on Lease**), Affidavit from local resident attesting registrant is living with owner, Current Real Estate Tax Bill, Mortgage Papers,

One Document from Category II:

Drivers License with Correct Address, Auto Registration, Home/Apartment Insurance, Paper Copy of Current* Utility Bill (Gas, Electric, Phone), Voter registration, Credit Card Bill, Current* Bank Statement, Current* Public Aid Card. (*Current=May, June, July—NOT older than 3 mos.)

Student School Supplies are provided for families committing to help our students achieve.



Parents and students completing registration at this time will meet their teachers, learn about their classroom assignments and enjoy some frozen treats. They will also receive free school supplies from the district.

Payment and Fees

Payments and Fees: You may pay fees with cash, money order or cashier's check (no personal checks), or, you may pay on-line with credit or debit. If you are unable to pay the entire amount for fees for your child/children at registration, we would be happy to set up a payment plan so that you may pay a monthly fee until the fees are paid.

Registration Fee/per Student for the School Year

Kindergarten - 1st and 2nd Grades	\$60.00
3rd and 4th Grade	\$70.00
5th-6th-7th and 8th Grade	\$80.00
Graduation Fees	\$25.00
7 TH and 8 th Grade Heart Monitor Strap	\$10.00

If you feel you qualify for a fee waiver, you must fill out an application at the time of registration. Acceptable proof of income **MUST** be provided: Two Current Pay Stubs for all working members of the household-Disability showing benefits-Unemployment showing benefits-Current Tax returns-proof of Direct Certification letter from State of Illinois-Proof of TANF-Foster placement papers.

Parent Sign-Off

Parents: visit the district web-site prior to the August registration dates, read the required information and be prepared to sign off that you have completed this process at the time of registration.

New to our District?

Students new to the district will need to bring their ORIGINAL Birth Certificate and transfer paperwork from previous school and IEP if applicable. Call the district office at 630-734-6670 after July 1st to start the registration process. All students must attend the August 15th Registration Day.

Do I Need Physical Forms?

Students entering Kindergarten and Sixth (6) grade must turn in the required physical forms. These forms are available on the district's registration page.

If your child has a medical condition that we should be aware of, please bring a doctor's note or other documentation with you for our files.

Looking Forward to Seeing Students and Parents on August 15th

After completing the Registration process on Tuesday, August 15th between 10:30AM-7:00PM, parents and students will have the opportunity to **meet their teachers and learn about the many outstanding learning and enrichment activities our school and our community partners have to offer as we celebrate the return to school.** Parents and students completing registration at this time will also receive free school supplies from the district.

Parents who do not complete registration at this time will not be able to have their child attend school until this process is completed. Sadly, children not registered on August 15th will **not** be provided free school supplies. Students not registered on August 15th will **not** be able to attend the important first days of school until an appointment can be made with building secretaries to complete the registration process.
